# The current climate of Health and Safety

## The delivery

The program is designed with 6 sessions, usually 1 x 1.5 hour sessions for each week over a period of 6 weeks. We would schedule 1 session a week which gives employees time to develop improvement initiatives in between. Ideally the first 3 sessions will be online and last 3 sessions will be facilitated on site however we can discuss tailoring the delivery to suit your needs.

The program will consist of training with our consultants and then learner assessment at the completion of the training to confirm the learner's knowledge and skills gathered.

## Outcomes

Learners who successfully complete all training and assessment requirements will be awarded a Nationally Accredited Statement of Attainment for the two (2) units completed; BSBWHS401 and BSBRSK401.

### Health and Safety

One topic that we have found benefits all businesses is health and safety. Every business experience some form of health and safety issues that continually arises and are never completely resolved. When this occurs people's health and safety can be impacted.

This part qualification will provide the skills and knowledge required to identify risks and to apply established risk management processes to a defined area of operations that are within the responsibilities and obligations of the role.

It also describes the skills and knowledge required to implement and monitor an organisation's work health and safety (WHS) policies, procedures, and programs in the relevant work area in order to meet legislative requirements.

It applies to individuals with a broad knowledge of risk analysis or project management who contribute well developed skills in creating solutions to unpredictable problems through analysis and evaluation of information from a variety of sources. They may have responsibility to provide guidance or to delegate aspects of these tasks to others.

This is also suitable for employees with supervisory responsibilities for implementing and monitoring the organisation's WHS policies, procedures and programs in a work area. These individuals have a broad knowledge of WHS policies and contribute well developed skills in creating solutions to unpredictable problems through analysis and evaluation of information from a variety of sources.

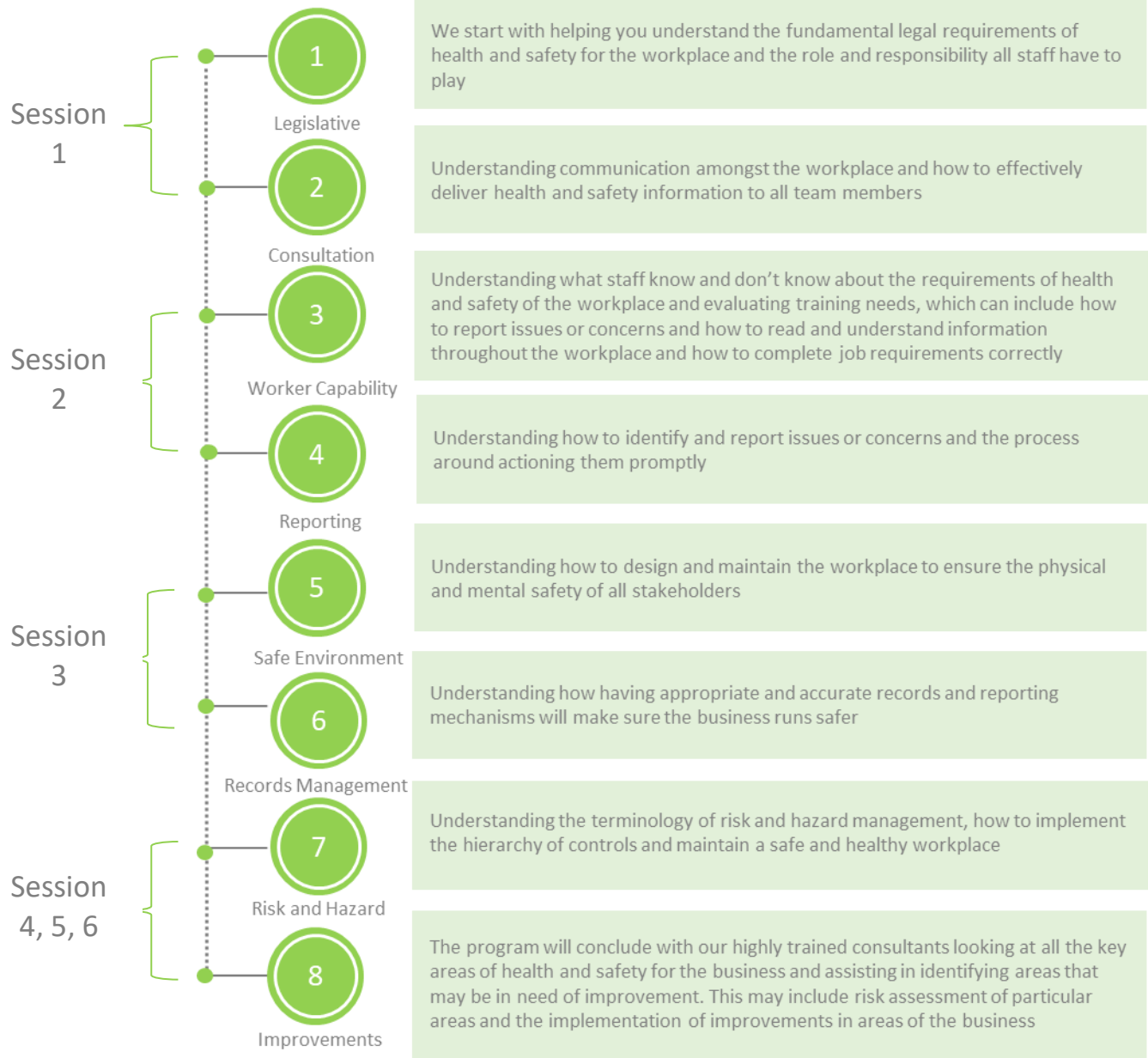
